1) January 24: Sheer fused collage

2) February 28 Cloth collage

Using fat quarters, and a picture for inspiration, we'll create a small fused quilt. Raw edges. Machine quilt and/or hand embroider. 12x12 suggested. Knife edge finishing. <http://inaminuteago.com/stitchindex.html> dictionary of hand embroidery stitches

3) March 28 Monoprinting on fabric

Golden *Open* Acrylics <http://www.dickblick.com/products/golden-open-acrylic-sets/>
Bring: white or off white fabric, scissors (or X-acto knife if you have one)
Freezer Paper (8-1/2x11 freezer paper at QP, can also be printed on)

You do not need to purchase the open acrylics. I'll bring some for use in class.

4) April 25 Circles!

Bring: a selection of fabrics (fat quarter size of each is plenty) in colors/patterns that work together (or purchase at QP)
Scissors
fusible webbing (mistyfuse is especially good for hand sewing)

5) June 27 RUST!

I'll demo the rusting on fabric process, Shiva Paintstiks (oil paint in a stick form) with project to TBA
