January 22: FIRST CLASS

We'll be creating a small art quilt ~ 9x12"

You'll need an image for the focal point (from your sketchbook or simple images like in coloring books—not too detailed)

Fabric: an assortment (like fat quarters) in colors, patterns that suite your image

Freezer paper (by the roll at the grocery store, or in 8.5x11 inch sheets) if you prefer to use paper backed fusible webbing)

White Elmer's type glue or glue stick or share with a friend (not necessary if you're using fusible webbing)

Scissors

Straight pins

notebook
