

## THE CITY BAG / TOWNE PURSE Supply List

**Pattern:** Lazy Girl Designs #112, The City Bag  
(finished size approximately 11" x 17")

OR Lazy Girl Designs #107, Towne Purse  
(finished size approximately 14" x 8 1/2")

**Fabric:**

	Outside fabric	Lining/Contrast fabric	Batting**	"Ugly" fabric***	Zipper****
City Bag	1 1/2 yards + 1/2 yard *	1 yard	3/4 yard	3/4 yard	20"
Towne Purse	1 yard	1 1/4 yards	1/2 yard	3/4 yard	18"

\* OPTIONAL, if you want to do 2 extra exterior back pockets.

\*\* Batting: any thin quilt batting is fine, but please DO NOT use craft fleece as suggested in pattern.

\*\*\* "Ugly" fabric: use a light/medium fabric from your stash as the back of quilt sandwich. Once your purse is assembled, you will never see it again, so it does not need to match; just be sure it won't show through your lining or outside fabric.

\*\*\*\* Zipper: Any standard zipper (except metal teeth!) will do, but I prefer a heavier, purse or sport (greater color selection) zipper. If you can't find exact size listed above, buy a longer one and we will adjust it in class.

**Sewing machine**, in good working order

zipper foot and even-feed or walking foot recommended

needles: Jeans/Denim 80/12 or Microtex Sharp 80/12

**Basic sewing supplies**, including:

50- or 40-weight thread of appropriate color

thread nippers or small scissors

fabric scissors, sharp

straight pins

ruler(s): 6" x 12" is a convenient size, or as available

marking chalk or pencil of a color to contrast with your fabrics

**Homework:** If you will cut out the pieces for your purse and label them according to the appropriate dimensions on the following page, as well as quilting the outside fabric before you come to class, it is possible to go home with a finished purse! "Quilting the outside fabric": use one each of **A**, **B** and **C** to form a quilt sandwich and quilt as desired. Repeat for second set of **A**, **B** and **C**.
