

# Fabric Baskets Supply List

Cotton clothesline rope (1 package is enough to make this project). This rope can often be found at WalMart; however, if you cannot find it, the teacher will have it at class.

Sewing machine

#90 sharp sewing machine needles

Permanent glue stick

Walking foot or appliqué foot or zig zag foot

Scissors / rotary cutter

Cutting mat

Ruler

Fabric cut  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide by width of fabric (it is recommended that you cut the fabric before class to ensure that you'll complete the project in class)

1 – 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards of fabric (enough for this project)

Batiks, multicolored prints work great

Avoid bulky fabrics (e.g., flannel)

It is not necessary to cut fabric strips perfectly

It does not matter if the fabric strip cuts are on bias crosswise or lengthwise grain
