

Hunter Star Supply List

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This is a unique and simple way to make the 8-pointed star. You will be amazed at how the block comes together with perfect points and no pesky Y- seams.

Fabric requirements

Light background fabric—3/4 yd.

Dark background fabric—3/4 yd.

Star fabric—1 yd

Border fabric—1 yd

If you want a more scrappy effect, you may choose more than one fabric for the stars if you wish. Also, if you are making a bed sized quilt, increase the fabric requirements accordingly

Other supplies

Cutting mat and rotary cutter with a sharp blade

6 x 24" ruler or 6 x 12" ruler if you prefer

Square ruler **at least 9.5" square**

Sewing machine in good working order. Please bring your manual in case of problems. Don't forget the cord.

Thread, either to match your fabric or a neutral color.

Pins

Whatever other sewing supplies you choose to use.

Please note. The deadline for signing up for the class is April 15th. There is a minimum of 4 students for the class to be held. If the class needs to be cancelled, you will be notified. I strongly recommend that you wait to cut the fabric until you know the class is on. You can wait and cut the fabric until class time. It will just take a little longer. Please call me if you have any questions.

Before you come to class, please cut the fabric as follows.

Light background fabric

Cut 2 strips-7.5", selvage to selvage. From this cut 7.5" squares and then cut these diagonally to form triangles.

Cut 2 strips-8", selvage to selvage. From these, cut 16 rectangles, 2.5" x 8".

Dark background fabric

Cut this the same as the light background fabric.

Star fabric

Cut 5 strips 5.5", selvage to selvage. Cut these strips into rectangles 2.5" x 5.5"
