

QUILT-AS-YOU-GO TABLE RUNNER Supply List

- Cotton Theory Quilting Button-Back Runner booklet, #QY36
Published by Cotton Theory, LLC
- Fabric and Other Supplies as listed on page 3 of the booklet
 - Dr. Scholl's Molefoam Padding can be used in place of the Cotton Theory Adhesive Quilting Guide. Or, you can use several layers of painter's or masking tape, or even a short stack of Post-It Notes instead of the Guide.
 - Glue stick or spray adhesive is used for appliqués made from synthetic suede. If you prefer to make your appliqués from cotton fabric, please bring 1/4 yard of lightweight fusible web (i.e.; Lite Steam a Seam 2).
 - A good-quality, cotton/poly blend (80/20) batting may be substituted for the Cotton Theory Batting. If you plan to place hot serving dishes on your table runner, you might want to consider using 1/2 yard of Thermolam polyester batting, which is specially made to withstand heat. It's great for placemats and potholders.
- Sewing machine, in good working order; including instruction book, bobbins, foot control and power cord. Please, DO NOT bring a Singer Featherweight, as you must be able to sew zig-zag stitches.
- Walking/even-feed foot, 1/4" foot and edge-joining foot if available
(for Bernina machines, these are #37 and 10/10C)
- Rotary cutting equipment, including new/sharp blade, mat and ruler(s)
- Basic sewing supplies, including:
 - thread nippers or small scissors
 - sharp fabric scissors for cutting appliqué pieces
 - straight pins
 - small sewing ruler

If you can precut your fabrics and batting before class (page 4 of the booklet), you will have more sewing time in class! If you have any questions regarding materials for this class, please give me a phone call. I look forward to seeing you in class!

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
