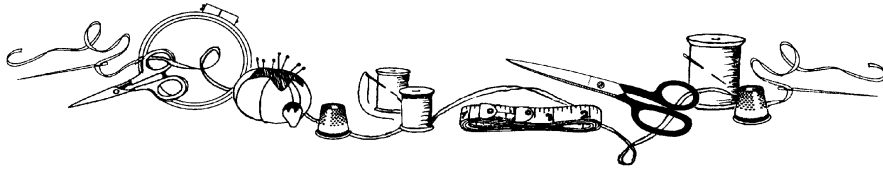


Quilt Your Favorite Photos



Quilt Your Favorite Photos Supply List

Book: Quilt Your Favorite Photos (Note: Patterns for 10 projects are included in the back of the book.)

Description of Class

Students may choose one of the ten projects in the book, or they may elect to bring their own photo to create their own pattern.

For students doing a book project, supplies and fabrics are listed in the book under each project.

For students creating their own pattern from their photograph, they will need the following supplies:

- Clear acetate or clear plastic sheet protector
- Extra fine Sharpie black pen for tracing your photo
- Your photo (of course)
- Large white paper to project your tracing onto the wall (I will bring an overhead projector for this part)

In addition, all students should bring:

- General sewing supplies, needles, threads, scissors, rulers, cutters, etc.
- Machine in good order
- Fabrics for your project (take your photo to the quilt shop, find fabrics that will work for your photo)
- Freezer paper
- Lite Steam-a-Seam 2 Fusible web
- Applique Pressing Sheet
- Tear away stabilizer
- Decorative threads for machine appliqué or
- Monofilament thread for invisible appliqué

Note: Students will not need to set up their sewing machine right away, so just put them under the table until we are ready to sew. Tracing and enlarging is done first, then refining and numbering your individual pieces.
