Supply List

Sewing Machine

¼ " foot or sewing guide

Seam ripper

Scissors

Fabric marking pencil (I use the sewline, multi-lead pencil)

1 box of sandwich bags (or 45 bags)

1 box of gallon zipper bags (or 20 bags)

Sharpie Fine Tip Marker

Rotary cutter with a fresh blade

6 ½ x 12 ½ " ruler

6 ½" square up ruler*

12 ½" square up ruler

Neutral thread

4 ½ " square up ruler (optional)*

Sewline glue pen (optional)

Rotating mat (optional)

*You may wish to get Quilter's Paradise's CutRite™ Square-Up Template Set that contains 5 square-up sizes: 10½", 8½", 6½", 4½" and 2½".

Fabric Requirements

This quilt is made up of 4 color families, with a range of values for each. The original sample uses red, green, gold and cream, while my sample uses pink, purple, turquoise, and white. You will need multiple shades within each color family to get the depth of color as seen in the samples. Please pay close attention to value as well as color when selecting colors, or pick your scheme, and we can help you select fabrics on the first class day. This is a great quilt to use up the leftovers or fat quarters from your stash, as you can literally use the smallest scraps of fabric. You can use multiple fabrics for each gradation, or keep it simple and have one fabric for each variant. We will discuss the advantages and disadvantages to each approach at the first meeting.

Color 1 (red/pink) – 4 gradations (light, medium, medium-dark, dark)

Color 2 (green/purple) – 5 gradations (light, medium-light, medium, medium-dark, dark)

Color 3 (gold/turquoise) – 2 gradations (light, medium)

Background (cream/white) – 1 (light)
