### Supply List

Applique Needles - # 10 Straw or Sharps

Clover Mini Iron & Ironing Mat

Sharp small scissors; one for paper, one for fabric

Small jar & brush for painting starch

Roxanne's Glue Baste It

Pencil for marking clipping on templates

& value placement on pattern.

I will be giving each person a layout pattern and all templates needed. I will also bring thread to use in class. You can take your own photos of the sample quilt so bring a camera.

Fabric kits are available for \$20.- and include all fabric needed, starch jar & brush, applique needle.

I have attached a separate sheet which shows how many fabrics & what sizes are needed to help if you are planning to use your own fabrics.

- Background Fabric - Cream - 18" x 28"
- Stems - Long - Green - 17" x 5"
- Long - Green - 10" x 6"
- Leaves - Greens - 5 - 7" squares
- Peony - Pinks - 7 - 7" squares
- Peony Center - Yellow - 1 - 4" square
- Starflower - Blue - 2 - 7" squares
- Starflower - Tan - 1 - 7" square
- Falling Flower - Golds - 5 - 7" squares
- Falling Flower Center - Rust - 1 - 4" square
- Inside Border - Blue - 1/4" yard
- & Narrow Binding
- Outer Border - Tan - 1/2 yard

Pattern, Templates, Starch, Jar & Brush Included

Finished Quilt - 23" x 33"

To finish project	Cut Sizes	Finished Sizes
1. Background	16 1/2" x 26 1/2"	16" x 26"
2. Inner Border	2 - 1 1/2" x 17 1/2"	3/4" x 17"
	2 - 1 1/2" x 27 1/2"	3/4" x 27"
3. Outer Border	2 - 2 1/2" x 22 1/2"	2" x 22"
	2 - 2 1/2" x 32 1/2"	2" x 32"
4. Binding	Single Thickness	Use 1" wide strips to finish with 1/2" wide binding
