



# Adhering Your ImagiCut™ Fusible Appliqué Duet

Thank-you for purchasing this ImagiCut™ Fusible Appliqué Duet! We hope that you experience fun and joy in creating your project and that it will be treasured for years to come. Please follow the directions below for adhering the ImagiCut Duet to your background fabric.

Tools required: damp cloth or paper towel, pin, sharp scissors, iron, ironing board.

Optional tools: pressing sheet, magnifier, portable light.



- 1 Remove the ImagiCut Fusible Appliqué Duet from the package and detach it from the cardstock.
- 2 Gently wipe both sides with a damp cloth or paper towel to remove any residue from the laser cutting process.

Please note that the ImagiCut Duet consists of 2 designs, a Primary and an Inverse design, each being the inverse image of the other. In Steps 3 – 9, you will be adhering the Primary design to a background fabric. Then in Step 10 you will adhere the Inverse design to a separate background fabric.



- 3 Place the ImagiCut Duet face down (fabric side down, paper side up) on a flat surface. Mark the pieces of the Primary design that you want to transfer to the background fabric.



- 4 Take a pin and, for each marked piece, score the paper connecting tabs from the piece so as to free the paper piece. Please only score the paper backing of the fusible and do **not** try to cut the threads that connect the piece. Remove the paper backing from the piece. The fusible glue should be exposed.

The paper backing of the Inverse design should remain in place and **not** be removed at this time.

- 5 Cut your background fabric to the desired size. (The background fabric must be larger than the design.)



- 6 Determine where on the background fabric you want to place the ImagiCut Duet. (If the background fabric is square or rectangular in shape and you want to center it on the background fabric, fold the background fabric in half lengthwise to create the background fabric and fold it again in half widthwise. Where the crease lines intersect is the center.)



- 7 Turn the ImagiCut Duet over (paper side down, fabric side up) and place the design on the background fabric where desired from Step 6. Use a pin to help place the ImagiCut Duet.

- 8 Press the ImagiCut Duet with an iron. The iron should be pre-heated to a silk (low heat) setting without steam. Press and hold the iron for 8 - 10 seconds, then move the iron to the next area to be pressed, and repeat until the entire design has been pressed. Allow the material to cool.

Please note that the pieces in the Primary design will adhere to the background fabric and the Inverse design will not adhere.



- 9 Gently lift the unattached part of the design to expose the threads that connect to the attached pieces. Carefully snip the threads with sharp scissors.

If nubs remain after trimming, use sharp scissors to carefully trim them off. Alternatively, when stitching the pieces of the design in Step 11, the stitches may hide the nubs.



- 10 Repeat Steps 3 – 9 with the Inverse design.



At this point, both designs of the ImagiCut Duet have now been adhered to your background fabric.

- 11 For each piece of the design, sew around the edge. Now is the time to use your machine's decorative stitches! Or, you can use a satin, blanket or zig-zag stitch. Alternatively, you can sew the pieces by hand.

- 12 If desired, embellish your project with beads, buttons, ribbons, embroidery – whatever your creative mind comes up with!
