





The CutRite[™] Bind Up tool

is used to join the two ends of your quilt's binding.

Instructions


Attach your binding, as you normally do, until there are approximately 10 inches remaining with 5 inches to the left of the finishing point and 5 inches to the right of the finishing point.






Step 5

Repeat Step 4 for the right binding strip. To do so, rotate the CutRite Bind Up tool so that the 'R' is face up, facing you in the upper right.




Step 6

Align the CutRite Bind Up tool evenly with the bottom of the cut binding and then cut off the tip on both the right and left binding.



Step 7

Put the right sides together from the left and right binding strips along the diagonal edge. Sew the left and the right binding strips together using a ¼-inch seam allowance and attach to quilt.
